Dear Parents and children,

At Reigate Priory we have a wide and varied range of extra curricular opportunities. The purpose of this newsletter is to clarify the options available to your child and give you the relevant information and forms. Please spend time with your child reading and discussing the following information on the various clubs available during the Spring Term.

School clubs can be categorised into two groups:

- **'Teacher Led'**: These are organised by teaching staff either before, at lunchtime or at the end of the school day. They are available to our pupils free of charge. Although no payment is necessary, your child is still required to show a degree of commitment.
- **Commercial**: These are run by external providers/companies. Although recognised by the school they are entirely separate concerns and therefore require payment. Registration letters for these clubs are attached to this form. All payments and enquires regarding Commercial clubs need to be made **directly** to the organiser of the club and **not** to the school. Payment details for these clubs are given on the relevant forms. Any issues or queries, such as those regarding cancellation, should be directed to the organisation running the club.

Teacher Led Clubs

To attend an **before/after school** 'teacher led' club, parents are required to provide a signed permission form available from the teacher leading the club. If your child is continuing in a club from the Autumn Term then NO new permission form is required.

All teacher led clubs that occur during the school day do **not** require this form.

Specific information relating to a club (such as equipment required) will either be provided at the first meeting (for Teacher Led clubs during school), or in the information/permission letter distributed prior to the beginning of the club (for after school Teacher Led clubs). In the meantime, if you or your child has any questions, please speak directly to the lead teacher of the club.

Teacher Led Clubs

Art Club (Year 4 only, 3HG)

Run by Miss Goldsmith, for children of all artistic abilities. There will be a mixture of drawing, painting and sculpture. Please make sure your child has an art apron.

Badminton Club (Year 5, Friday 7:50 – 8:40 in the gym)

Run by Mr E.Smith, this fast paced sport is loads of fun.

Board Games (Year 6 only)

Run by year 6 staff, this is an excellent way to while away those wintry lunch brakes.

Chess Club (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 Tuesday, 4RG)

Chess club brings all abilities together. From complete beginners to more experienced players. Take the opportunity to learn this fascinating game of strategy and pit your skills against other players. No equipment required – Mr. Goodall has plenty of chess sets (although any donated sets would be gratefully received).

Choir (all Year groups, Thursday, in the gym)

Open to boys and girls who enjoy singing and are keen to develop their singing voice. Excellent opportunities to show off your skills at assemblies, festivals and school productions. Run by Mrs Burns.

Cross Country Club (all Year groups, Tuesday lunchtime)

Run by Mr Moses, for runners/athletes of all abilities, and children who want to boost their overall fitness. A typical session begins with warm up games and activities, followed by fun drills to improve technique, before time spent running a route(s) within Priory Park, and finishing with warm down time. Kit required: games kit including socks, trainers/ running spikes (not plimsols!).

Dance Club (Y5 & Y6, Friday lunchtime, gym)

Run by Miss Phillips, Dance Club is for anyone in Years 5 and 6 who likes to move to funky music! The only equipment you will need is your body and your PE kit. We will create dances together, so bring some of your own ideas!

Football (Years 5 & 6, Tuesday after school)

Parental permission form required

A chance to practice and develop football skills. The club will be run by Mr. Purnell, and aims to produce a structured progression of skills, stamina and strength development. The school team will comprise of Year 6 pupils only. Although not all members of the Year 6 squad are guaranteed a place in the school team, we do try to rotate the squad as much as possible. Children get changed in classrooms and bring coats, bags etc over to the gym.

Green Club (all Year groups, Tuesday lunchtime)

Run by Mr. Pearce, the Green Club instills in our children an appreciation for our environment whilst experiencing the many miracles of nature. Last year the members of the Green Club were largely responsible for rejuvenating the Friendship Garden into the wonderful and relaxing area that it is today.

The garden is testament to the hard work and dedication of this band of slightly grubby, yet happy pupils. It is a hands-on club and you will experience all aspects of the responsibilities of planning, creating, and maintaining our garden and produce.

Gymnastics Club! (Year 4 and 5, Tuesday lunchtime, gym) Balances, jumps and rolls on mats and apparatus! Individual practice and group routines of gymnastics skills like forward rolls, backward rolls, log rolls, headstands, handstands, cartwheels, vaulting and many more! Gymnastics improves strength, balance, co-ordination and flexibility!

Homework Clubs (See overview sheet for each Year group's day)

A great opportunity for children with a busy home life! As well as giving the children the chance to complete their homework during the school day, Homework clubs give the children the opportunity to discuss and explore any areas of misunderstanding in a small group or even individual basis.

Japan Club (all year groups, Thursday lunchtime)

Run by Mr. Webb. Children in this class will learn basic Japanese and learn about Japanese culture from kimono to katana and sushi to Pokemon. Where it is held will depend on popularity of the club. The first meeting will be in 4AW.

Knitting & Needlework (Year 6 only)

Tired of that breeze down the back of your neck? Are your fingers ready to drop off? Is your head so cold your brain has begun to have trouble functioning? Join year 6 knitting club and you could learn to make your very own warm winter gear. This club is run by the Year 6 staff.

Netball (Year 6, Wednesday after school)

Year 6 netball will be held on a Wednesday after school by Mrs. Walters & Mrs. Challis. At 3:30 get changed in classrooms and meet by the basketball posts with all bags. Matches will hopefully be held on Tuesdays or Wednesdays after school.

Expectations

Reigate Priory School is very proud of the extensive range of extra curricular activities that are on offer to the children. To enable teacher led clubs to happen the staff voluntarily give up many hours of their own time.

It is our aim to give all children every opportunity to be involved in the clubs provided. The emphasis is on skill development, participation and enjoyment, while promoting the many health, personal and social benefits.

To ensure a fun and safe experience children are expected to arrive with the correct clothing and equipment. Please support your child in this matter. If your child does not possess the correct kit for any activity they may not be allowed to take part.

All children are expected to demonstrate a high standard of behaviour for any activity or club. Should their behaviour be deemed unacceptable, particularly with regards to safety, they may not be allowed to participate or even lose their place in that club.

Due to the number of children participating, attendance does NOT guarantee that any child will represent the school at events and/or competitions.

Although there is NO charge for any teacher-led clubs, children are expected to demonstrate a commitment to their chosen club.

Commercial clubs run their own programs separate from the school; any issues, problems or queries, such as those regarding cancellation, should be made directly to the provider of that club.

Postponement/cancellation – Teacher Led Clubs

If a club is to be cancelled it will be done prior too or the day before and a message provided to all club members. If the leading teacher is absent on the day of the club and therefore this is not possible, then another teacher will cover the session.

On poor weather days children will use a designated classroom (given in the clubs permission letter) and can be collected from the red sofas at the main entrance at the usual finishing time.

Daily information on teacher led clubs can be found on the whiteboard outside 3HG in the Year 3 corridor. We recommend that children attending these clubs check this board daily for any important notices.

Postponement/cancellation – Commercial Clubs

Commercial clubs are entirely responsible for notification and cover provision as a consequence of any postponements or cancellations. Any queries regarding this should be made directly to the club provider. If your child is absent from a session, it is a good idea to contact the club just in case any important information has been distributed, such as a future session cancellation.

Commercial Clubs

Each of these 'clubs' will have it's own information and 'sign-up' sheet, detailing times, place, cost, equipment required etc. These letters are attached to this document and are also available at www.reigate-priory.co.uk.

Please note that any queries regarding Commercial Clubs (payment problems, 'Is the club on today?', 'What date do you finish?' etc) need to be addressed directly to the organisation or course leader running the club and NOT to the school office.

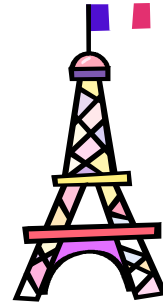
