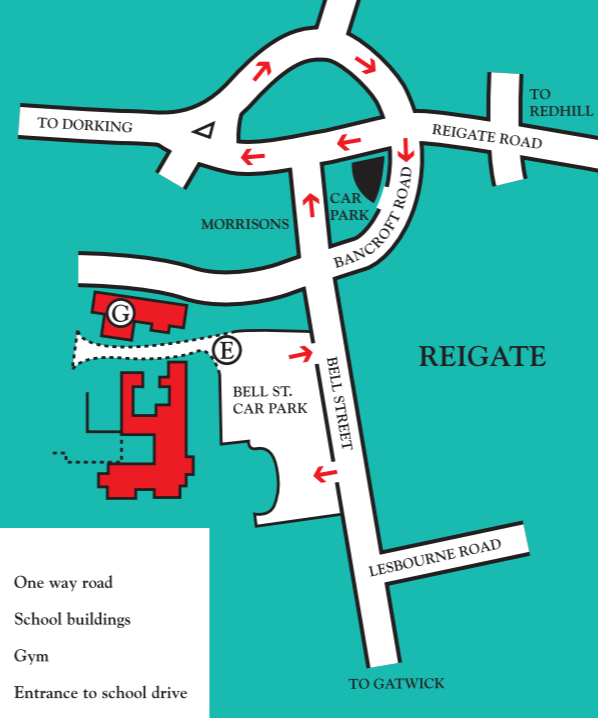

Admissions

Reigate Priory is a Junior School for boys and girls from 7-11 years old and is maintained by Surrey County Council. Admission follows SCC's Equal Preference System. Our published admission number (PAN) is 150. Should that number be exceeded, we will follow the admission criteria set by the Surrey Education Authority and use the following priorities when offering places:

1st priority

Looked after children (in the care of the local authority).

2nd priority

Exceptional arrangements (Special Educational Needs, medical grounds or other individual family circumstances).

3rd priority

Siblings (Those children who have an older brother or sister in the school at the time of admission).

4th priority

Children for whom the school is nearest to their home address. Distance will be measured by a straight line from the pupil's house.

5th priority

Any other applicant.
